5 TIPS FOR EVALUATING SHUTTERS

It's what's on the inside that counts

Ensure your shutters are 100% wood of a single species. Some shutters are made up of wood veneers over another cheaper wood species, wood composite, or synthetic material. Natural wood is healthier, more durable, and more environmentally responsible.

Hand selection is key

When buying a stained shutter, choose a company that employs careful hand selection of wood, ensuring the luxurious look of the natural grain is at its best, and that there are no imperfections.

Not all paints are the same

The best paint finish is achieved by using a 2-pack polyurethane paint (PU) which is used in kitchens and high-end cabinetry. Other shutters may be painted with inferior Nitro Cellulosic paint. PU gives a flawless finish every time.
